

George Andreou is Assistant Professor at the School of Political Sciences, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki in the field of “European Union Policies”. He has also taught at the University of Athens, the University of Crete, the University of the Peloponnese and the National School of Public Administration, Greece. His research interests include public policy analysis, the policies of the European Union and cohesion policy (regional/structural policy) in particular, the Europeanisation of public policies in the EU and the relations between Greece and the EU. He has published *New institutionalism in political science* (Kritiki, Athens 2018), *The New Cohesion Policy of the EU and Greece* with P. Liargovas (Papazisis, Athens 2007) and various articles in Greek and international academic journals; he has also contributed to several collective volumes (in Greek and English).
