Murat Önsoy holds a B.A in Political Science and an M.A in International Relations from Bilkent University,



Türkiye. As scholarship recipient of the Turkish Higher Education Council, he conducted his doctoral studies at the University of Erlangen/Nuremberg Institute for Contemporary Middle Eastern Studies/ Germany, and obtained a PhD degree with his thesis entitled "World War Two Allied Economic Warfare: The Case of Turkish Chrome Sales". Since April 2023 he is working as a professor at Hacettepe University department of International Relations. Önsoy has written several articles in Turkish, German and English on subjects including Turkish Foreign Policy, Western Balkans and German Politics. He is the founder and director of Hacettepe University Research Center for Turkish-

German Studies (HÜTAİ) and editor of a Web of Science/ESCI indexed journal entitled "Gazi Akademik Bakış Dergisi". He was a guest researcher at Hamburg University - ZEUS program from March 2015 to February 2016 where he conducted research on the peace building and democratization process of the Western Balkans.
